

The North Keywood Circuit, consisting of Blackwell Chapel United Methodist Church and Mahanaim United Methodist Church, desires to encourage members to further their education. To do so, each church receives donations which are combined to provide scholarship funds.

To be considered scholarship applicants must:

- 1. Be an active church member of BCUMC or MUMC.
- 2. Have a 2.5 GPA in high school or a 2.0 GPA in college while being enrolled full-time (12 credits minimum).
- 3. Submit the North Keywood Circuit Scholarship Application with an unofficial transcript attached.
- 4. Apply by July 1 of each year so scholarships can be awarded in a timely manner.
- 5. Be aware that scholarships are awarded once a year for the fall semester.
- 6. Submit application to the pastor or treasurer of home church. (The pastor and two treasurers will review applications and make awards on the last Sunday in July).
- 7. Submit a new application with unofficial transcript attached each year.
- Rev. Scott Spence brought the idea for the North Keywood Scholarship to both churches to promote continued learning. Both churches saw this concept as being a valuable ministry which would have long lasting benefits. Donation receptacles (handcrafted churches made by Kim Coe) were placed in each church.
- Scholarship recipients are strongly encouraged to be involved with their home church activities whenever possible, or attend church near their respective institution if living away from home.
- The blessings of both churches go with the recipients as they move forward in advancing their education. We request that each recipient send a note of thanks to both churches upon being awarded a scholarship.
